STUDENT/NOVICE (Any age, any media, anyone studying the arts who has not yet won an art show award). Must pre-register.

Show judge reserves the right to move entries into different categories as they deem appropriate. If there are less than 6 entries in any category they will be assigned to Open Media. All art must be pre-entered by Aug. 27, 2024; no entries or changes will be accepted at check-in.

RULES

Please submit only original art, no copies of another artist's photo, drawing or painting, no classwork, no prints. Works should be completed within the last 3 years, and not shown previously in a DFA show. No jewelry or craft items.

Two dimensional artwork must be **labeled in the upper left back** with Title, Artist, Media (or Student), and price (or NFS—Not for Sale). Three-dimensional work must be labeled on the **bottom** with Title, Artist, Media, and Price (or NFS — Not for Sale). Labels on artwork must match registration information.

Frame Size 8" x10" minimum up to 32" x 40" maximum. Glass in frames cannot exceed 24" x 30" (except for plexiglass). Framing or gallery wrap must be professional quality with wire hanger (**no saw-tooth hangers**).

BIN ART: Artists paying fees to enter the show are permitted to bring 'bin art' to sell only if work is protected by plastic or acetate, not framed, and labeled as stated above. DFA and The Creamery Art Center are not responsible for the safety of bin art.

Any artwork not meeting these standards or that is not pre-registered will not be shown. All artwork must remain on display for the duration of the show (except for any bin art sold during the show).

ENTRY FEES

• **Artist/Photographer:** \$15 per entry or 3 entries for \$30

Student/Novice: FREE entry for novices studying the arts; may enter up to 2 pieces.

AWARDS

- Best of Show \$200
- 1st Place \$100, 2nd Place \$75, 3rd Place \$50
- \$25 Merit Awards for top 3 Student/Novice entries.

Other awards, prizes or merchandise may be awarded at the discretion of local businesses and sponsors .

SALES

The Creamery Arts Center retains a 40% commission on all work sold during the show. *Total price listed on artist's registration form must include commission.* DFA does not earn any commission on show sales.

JUDGE

A Colorado-based painter, Sherry Cobb-Kelleher creates paintings showing moments of time from the western lifestyle she lives, working primarily in oil, with secondary mediums of pencil and watercolor. Growing up on a ranch in Southwestern Colorado gave Sherry intimate knowledge of her subjects. Her work explores the true western lifestyle and everything that goes with it – animals and people, as well as the environment that surrounds them.

By combing a mastery of light with a strong foundation of drawing and composition, she has developed a unique style that brings to life the details of the world she loves.

Sherry has received the Directors Choice Award and the Patron's Award at the 2019 "CowGirl Up!" Exhibition & Sale, as well as the Patron's Choice Award in 2022. Other recent awards include "Best Associate" at The WAOW 52nd National Exhibition 2022 for her painting titled " Evening On Buttermilk Creek."
